PROTESTS AND COMPLAINTS.

All questions of eligibility, qualification of players or interpretation of rules shall be referred to the Management Committee, but no objection relative to the dimensions of the playing area or the Committee shall entertain other appurtenances, unless a protest is lodged with the referee before commencement of the game. Contact organiser in a respectful & dignified manner.

APPEALS:

Any appeal against a decision of the Management Committee must be made in duplicate to the sectioning Association within 14 days of the posting of the decision of the Management Committee and be accompanied by an appeal fee of £60.

MISCONDUCT.

All cases of misconduct shall be reported to and dealt with by the appropriate County Football Association. The Nott's FA sanctions this event and therefore all disciplinary matters WILL be reported.

The committee reserve the right to request any person or team who are under influence of alcohol or drugs or are in major breach of the codes of conduct to leave the tournament immediately without refund of any fees.

All Teams, Managers, Match Officials & Spectators are requested to follow the

WARM UP : **DO NOT WARM UP ON PITCHES PLEASE** (find a place outside Pitch area)

RESPECT : Applies to all Visitors to the Tournament, make it an enjoyable day for everyone.

QUICK OVERVIEW RULES:

- 1) **Academy Players & Player registered or linked to professional clubs are not eligible to play in this competition.**
- 2) All Teams to provide 1 x Match ball
- 3) All Clubs to provide 1st Aid Kit
- 4) Maximum number of Players per Team (10)
- 5) Please arrive at your designated pitch 5 minutes before the scheduled start.
- 6) **FORMAT** : 7 a-side (except Under 8s , which will be 5 a-side.)
- 7) **PERIOD**: 10 Minutes (one way)
- 8) **START OF GAME**: Drop Ball Start , Signalled by Horn (all Games start at the same time)
- 9) **END OF GAME & ADDED TIME**: Dictated by the Referee, signalled by Final Whistle.
- 10) **GOALKEEPER**: Can move out of the Goal Area
- 11) **OUTFIELD PLAYERS**: Allowed in all areas of Pitch, including Goal Area
- 12) **SUBSTITUTES**: Roll on /Roll Off during stoppages only, Acknowledged by Referee.
- 13) **RE-START**: After a Goal the game continues with a normal Kick off from the Centre.
- 14) **FREE KICKS**: Direct
- 15) **THROW INS** : Normal Mini Soccer Rules
- 16) **GOAL KICKS & RETREAT RULE**: U7s,8s,9s & 10s For Goal Kicks the opposing team will immediately move back to the half way line. U11s will roll the ball in (underarm)
- 17) **REFEREE** : His Decision is Final and should be respected by Players, Managers & parents, even if you feel they are wrong.
- 18) **RESPECT**: Please ask players to shake hands after the Game.
- 19) **TEAM COLOURS**: All teams must have a change of strip or provide Bibs in the event of a colour clash, when the second named team in the programme will be required to change. All players must wear shin pads and suitable footwear. Players shall be dressed in uniform shirts and shorts, but goalkeepers shall wear colours which distinguish them from other players and referees. The goalkeepers may wear tracksuit bottoms.

IMPORTANT RULES:

GOAL KEEPER:

- 1) Goal Keepers can come out of the Goal Area to clear a ball. They cannot pick it up outside the area
- 2) Pass backs allowed, but Keeper must kick ball (free kick awarded 1mtr outside Area)
- 3) The exception to the Pass back Rule will be under 8s only, they will not be penalised for picking up the ball.

GOAL KICKS:

- 1) Taken by the Goal Keeper from within the Goal Area
- 2) Under ,8, 9 &10s Attacking team to Retreat to Half way line.
- 3) Under 11s there will be no Goal Kicks allowed, Re-start will be by the Keeper rolling the ball in underarm.

OUTFIELD PLAYERS

- 1) Players are allowed in the Goal Area.

PENALTIES

- 1) Given for a deliberate foul inside the area by a defending player
- 2) Given for deliberate Hand ball inside the area by a defending player
- 3) Any normal Infringement as per Mini Soccer rules

THROW INS:

- 1) Normal Mini Soccer Rules . Teams cannot score directly from a throw-in.

FREE KICKS :

- 1) Will be given for a Foul, Hand ball or other infringement covered by the rules of Mini Soccer.
- 2) All Free kicks are Direct (Defending team to be a minimum of 5mts from the Ball)

GOALS

- 1) Restart with normal Kick off from Centre by the team who has conceded the Goal.

INJURIES:

- 1) Once game has stopped the Player should leave the field of Play & be replaced.
- 2) In the case of a serious injury the game will be stopped & will be delayed until suitable action can take place.

ADDED TIME: The Referee will add what he deems as suitable added time for injuries.

END OF GAME: The End of the game will be signalled by the Referee.

KNOCK OUT STAGE: In the event of a draw in normal time, the match will be decided on Penalties

RED AND YELLOW CARDS.

Any player booked in any match shall miss the next match irrespective of the stage of the tournament. Any player dismissed from any match shall be excluded from the rest of the tournament. This decision is NOT negotiable – we will always back our referees. ANY TEAM FOUND PLAYING PLAYERS THAT HAVE EITHER BEEN CAUTIONED OR DISMISSED WILL BE EXCLUDED AND ASKED TO LEAVE OUR TOURNAMENT WITH IMMEDIATE EFFECT.

CLUB NAMES.

No clubs must enter this competition in the name of an affiliated club without the full knowledge and authority of that club.

TROPHIES.

A main trophy will be presented to the winning teams.

FIRST AID.

All teams shall be responsible for supplying suitable first aid kit for carrying out minor injuries.

COMPETITION FORMAT:

8 Teams split into 2 Leagues

2 Top teams go into Cup knockout competition

2 bottom teams go into Trophy knockout competition
